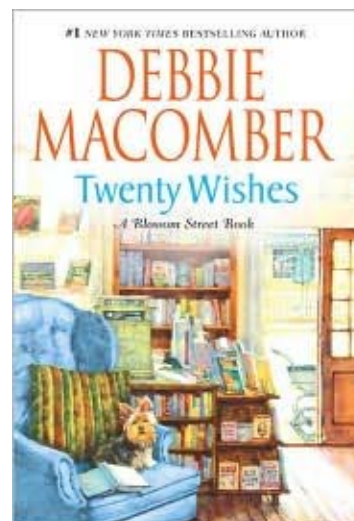

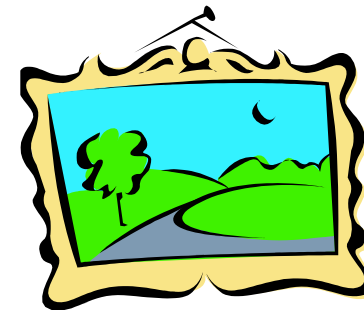

## TRAVELING ART

The Raymond A. Whitwer Tilden Public Library is hosting the "New Beginnings" traveling art show from Prairie Winds Art Center of Grand Island, NE beginning Friday, April 3.

This unique show is made up of pieces that are uniformly sized to be 7" X 7"(image) and framed to be 15" X 17". Although uniform in size, there is a wide variety of styles (abstract to realism), subject matter (nonobjective to objective) and media (oil, watercolor, acrylic, collage, textiles, pastel etc). Three dimensional pieces (wood, glass and ceramic) are also included in this traveling exhibit which consists of about 50 pieces.
